Executive Order **PROCLAMATION**

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS, The role of the professional public safety dispatcher is vital to the protection of human life and property and to the preservation of law and order as guaranteed by the U.S. Constitution; and
- WHEREAS, The incident of crime, alcohol and drug abuse, suicides, domestic situations and broken homes are daily occurrences in our society; and
- WHEREAS, The professional public safety dispatcher is the pivotal link between citizens and those who provide service when accidents or emergency circumstances occur which require the assistance of firemen, police and EMS services; and
- WHEREAS, Professional public safety dispatchers perform their daily tasks in a dedicated, diligent and loyal manner while enduring the occupational stresses of shift work, confinement, periods of heavy volumes of radio traffic and crisis situations requiring responsible and decisive actions; and
- WHEREAS, The State of Indiana is fortunate to be blessed with dedicated and well trained professional public safety dispatchers; and
- WHEREAS, These professionals need and deserve informed citizen support and recognition for their commitment and devotion to the quality public safety dispatching services;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mitchell E. Daniels, Jr., Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim April 12 - 18, 2009 as
