Re: Approval for the use of Enviro-Septic® Systems in Indiana

The use of Presby Environmental, Inc., Enviro-Septic® systems is hereby approved in Indiana by the Indiana State Department of Health (department), under the provisions of 410 IAC 6-8.1-31(g), subject to the conditions contained in the attached document entitled *Indiana Standards for Enviro-Septic® Soil Absorption Field Technology*.

This approval may be revoked or modified by the department for non-compliance, or if it is documented that it would not be in the best interests of public health for approvals to continue.

If you want to request a review of this approval, you must petition the Director of Consumer Protection of the department for review, in writing, on or before October 31, 2005, demonstrating that you are aggrieved or adversely affected by this approval, or you are entitled to review under any law. If a petition for review is granted pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-7, and you are not a party thereto, notices of any prehearing conferences, preliminary hearings, hearings, stays and other orders disposing of the proceedings may be obtained by sending a request for notice to the Director of Consumer Protection of the department.
