SUBJECT: Residential and Commercial On-site Sewage Systems and
Recessional Moraines in Northeastern Indiana

The recessional moraines in northeastern Indiana extend into parts of northern and southern Huntington County. Because of their presence in Huntington County, the recessional moraine procedures outlined in my memoranda must be applied to Huntington County.

However, a review of soils and recessional moraine information for Huntington County indicates that the procedure does not need to be applied county-wide.

Therefore, the procedure must be applied, when applicable, to only the following areas in Huntington County:

- ◆ Sections 1 thru 4, 9 thru 12, 13 thru 16, 21 thru 24, 25 thru 28, and 33 thru 36 of Township 29N, Range 8E
- ◆ All of Township 29N, Range 9E
- ◆ All of Township 29N, Range 10 E
- ◆ All of Township 27 N, R 10 E
- ◆ Sections 1 thru 4, 9 thru 12, 13 thru 16, 21 thru 24, 25 thru 28, and 33 thru 36 of Township 26N, Range 8E
- ◆ All of Township 26N, Range 9E
- ◆ All of Township 26N, Range 10E
