SUBJECT: Residential and Commercial On-site Sewage Systems and
Recessional Moraines in Northeastern Indiana

The recessional moraines in northeastern Indiana extend into northern Delaware County. Because of their presence in Delaware County, the recessional moraine procedures outlined in my memoranda must be applied to Delaware County.

However, a review of soils and recessional moraine information for Delaware County indicates that the procedure does not need to be applied county-wide.

Therefore, the procedure must be applied, when applicable, to only the following areas in Delaware County:

- ◆ Sections 7 thru 30 and Sections 32 thru 36 of Township 22N, Range 11E
- ◆ Sections 1 thru 24 and 26 thru 30 of Township 21N, Range 11E
- ◆ Sections 7 thru 28 of Township 22N, Range 10E
- ◆ Sections 10 thru 15 and Sections 23 and 24 of Township 22N, Range 9E
