Antonia requested help on identifying trends and breaking the data down for the strategic meeting in March. Trends were discussed with some being identified as: Lack of knowledge on services, lack of empathy in general, lack of services/child care. DCS can use foster placement as childcare or the other two licenses agencies in town, however that is not enough for the residents. More access is needed.
